Embark - start of a journey.

Solidification - process of making something strong or united.

Political affairs - having to do with politics. The events or workings of governments.

Disciple - One who embraces and assists in spreading the teachings of another.

Compiled - To gather into a single book.

Rendered - interpreted.

Emphasis - stressing a point.

Fundamental - Forming or serving as an essential component (foundation) of a system or structure.

Benevolence - An inclination to perform kind, charitable acts. Being kind.
